down to the restaurant for Sunday lunch and we hope you can join us to continue the discussions.

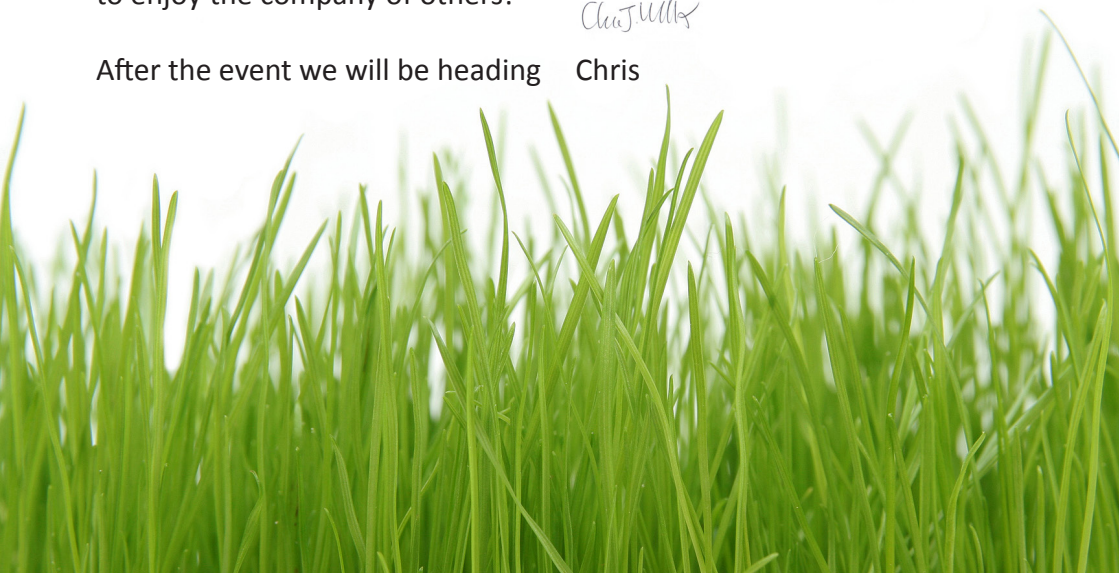
